



## OCHRE HEALTH PTY LTD AND UC-HRI SCHOLARSHIP

Applications are now open for a scholarship through Ochre Health Pty Ltd and supported by the University of Canberra Health Research Institute.

The project "Factors that influence quality improvement in general practice" will be undertaken with Ochre Health Pty Ltd at the University of Canberra.

The Principal Supervisor is Professor Stephen Campbell who is based at the Institute of Population Health, Centre for Primary Care Manchester University, and is seconded to the University of Canberra on a parttime basis.

The Supervisory panel will also include academic staff from the Health Research Institute at the University of Canberra and a representative from Ochre Health.

A tax-free living allowance (stipend) will be paid at the rate of AU \$27,000 per annum.

The successful candidate may be employed by Ochre Health for up to 1 day a week of paid work in addition to the stipend scholarship.

## TO APPLY

Candidates must submit a cover letter, full Curriculum Vitae (CV), an academic transcript and two academic references.

Interviews will be held in mid-July 2015.

The successful candidate will be expected to enrol in a Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) and produce a minimum of four first-author peer reviewed publications during their candidature.
