The Alliance seeks an energetic person with a strong record in research in a health-related field to lead the *AJRH* Editorial team. The Editor will maintain the highest standards of scholarly publication. Previous experience editing a peer reviewed research journal and superior writing and editing skills are essential. An understanding of current issues in rural and remote health and a commitment to multi-disciplinary collaboration are also required. The position is honorary. The term of appointment is three years, with an option to extend to a maximum term of five years.
